Introduction

What is the MHPSS Directory?

The MHPSS Directory is a broad and detailed list of organisations providing mental health and social support services to people on the West Bank of the occupied Palestinian territory.

Who is the MHPSS Directory for?

The Directory is designed for people looking for mental health and psychosocial support for themselves or others. The resource can also support professionals, such as medical practitioners, social workers, and administrators who need to refer people to relevant mental health and psychosocial services on the West Bank.

About us

We are a team of researchers based at Birzeit University and King's College London. Our work seeks to better understand community inclusion and participation of people with mental illness in the community. As part of this, we mapped mental health and psychosocial support services available to people on the West Bank to make them more accessible.

The Directory lists 40 governmental and non-governmental organisations offering services that include:

- Social support (e.g., social activities, training, mentoring)
- Family support (e.g., activities for parents and children, counselling on marriage, family disputes and domestic violence)
- Well-being focused services (e.g., mental health and physical health support including diagnosis and treatment, emotional support, community support groups)

Some services are provided to all groups, others are specifically designed for women, children, adolescents, older people or survivors of torture.
